


# PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT



### STEP 1: INITIAL INTERVIEW

Initial interviews are for collecting information about the clients history, family history, referral concerns, and planning. Detailed discussion as to whether assessment is the best choice and referrals are provided, if required.

#### **STEP 2: TESTING**

Testing is a general term for all direct assessment sessions with the client (e.g., cognitive, academic, behavioural examinations/activities), as well as clinical interviews (e.g., mental health/behavioural), other interviews, (e.g., parent/teacher), and relevant questionnaires.





# STEP 3: ANALYSIS & REPORT WRITING

Several important activities take place "behind the scenes." Thorough review of previous records and reports, scoring and interpretation of all testing materials, comprehensive analysis and case formulation, report writing, & development of personalised recommendations.

## STEP 4: RESULTS MEETING

A detailed and comprehensive review of all results and conclusions, as well as next steps and recommendations.
